

Carbon Calculator Contest Rules

1. Purpose

The Georgian Bay Biosphere is holding and administering a promotional contest to encourage participation in the carbon calculator. The carbon calculator is available in paper and online at: gbr.ca/carbon-calculator

2. Duration of Contest

The Carbon Calculator contest will begin August 17, 2020 and end on November 4, 2020.

3. Drawing Winners

Starting September 2, 2020, two (2) winners will be selected weekly at random from the pool of eligible entries. There will be a total of ten (10) weekly draws, with a total of twenty (20) winners over the course of the contest. Draws will be held every Wednesday (time TBA), concluding November 4, 2020. Winners will be contacted by email and must provide proof of eligibility. After 5 business days without a response, the prize will be forfeited to a runner-up.

3. Prizes

Each winner will receive one (1) gift card to a local food establishment, valued at \$25. One (1) gift card will be allocated to winners at random, from local establishments such as:

b. To be eligible for a prize, participants must have completed the carbon calculator truthfully, and to the best of their abilities.

c. Employees or family members of the organization involved in the administration of the contest are **not eligible** for a prize. They are still welcome to complete the carbon calculator.

5. General Rules

a. Each household is allowed a maximum of 1 entry.

b. A winning participant's ballot will be removed from subsequent draws. Re-taking the carbon calculator **does not** grant a participant a new ballot in the following draws.

c. Past carbon calculator entries are eligible, but participant entry information and consent was not previously collected. Please contact climate@gbbr.ca to determine eligibility and enter the draw.
